REGISTRATION FOR CAMP

Please register online & pay with a credit card. In order to receive the Early Bird Registration Discount, the Camp Office must receive a **COMPLETED FORM WITH PAYMENT** on or before the

June 2nd deadline.

CANCELLATION POLICY

For all camps, fees are refundable with the exception of \$25. If the camp office is notified of the cancellation at least one week prior to the camp session starting, the remainder will be reimbursed.

CHECK-IN & PICK UP PROCEDURES

1. Camp check-in and dismissal times are listed inside your booklet. At registration, HRCA will be checking temperatures due to state regulations. (NOTE: Indiana is on Eastern Time)

2. If a camper needs to leave the camp at other times, written parental permission must be received by the camp office. Upon departure, campers must sign out in the office, and when campers return, they must sign back in. It is best for campers not to leave camp.

3. At the end of each event, campers will be dismissed and checked out. For camps that end with baptisms, campers will not be released until the END of baptisms. Written parental permission must be given to the Camp Office if a camper is to leave with someone other than a parent or legal guardian.

Most pickup times are 4:00pm.

Please pay close attention to the time your camper needs to be picked up.
