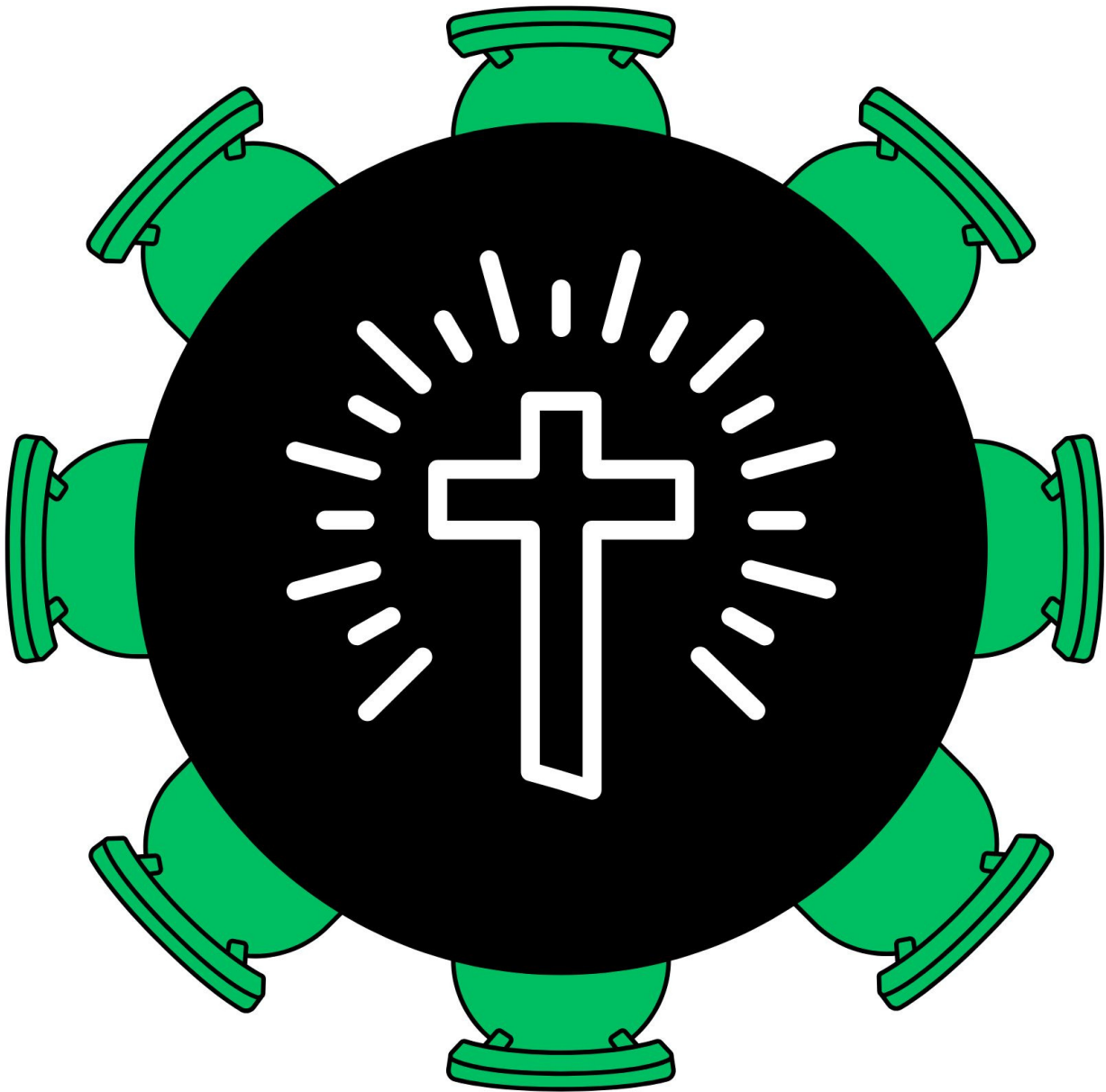

WHY IT MATTERS

Hanging Rock has sparked joy in campers of all ages since 1946. As we continue to thrive, we look with joy to the future of this critical ministry. In order to continue offering high-quality, transformational programs, we must add more functional facilities and update buildings that are no longer adequate.

This dining hall project will allow more campers to experience the joy of camp and also improve our long-term financial strength and sustainability. We have reached the point, in our growth, where we have been very creative in making our current dining hall feasible to accommodate the growing number of people we are serving. We have had to utilize the foyer of the gym, the gym, classrooms, and outside (weather permitting) all as spaces to feed the growing number of campers.

Over the years, Hanging Rock has diligently cared for its facilities and periodically undertaken new projects to address specific needs.

As Hanging Rock has reached record breaking attendance during camp and retreats the one facility that has caused us to be creative in making room is the dining room. Our current dining room was built when the camp purchased the property in 1946. Currently the dining hall can accommodate 120 for retreat season and 150 for summer camp. Our total bed capacity is 250. We are in need of another 100-200 seats in our dining room.

Currently, campers eat in shifts, which is both inefficient and logistically problematic. The serving areas are also undersized, which causes congestion and impacts Hanging Rock's commitment to hospitality.



The Benefits

The benefits of having a dining hall that can accommodate everyone at the same time will accomplish the following goals:

1. The quality of food will be enhanced. Long serving lines and eating in shifts will be eliminated.
2. Eliminating eating in shifts will create shorter work periods for kitchen workers and a longer turnaround time for the next meal.
3. Dining Room capacity will match or exceed current bed capacity.
4. The noise level will be improved with more space between campers.
5. Campers will enjoy a dining room experience where they do not feel rushed.
